
I write on behalf of my client, Ms. [REDACTED]; my G-28 is attached, along with a copy of her green card<sup>1</sup>, Canadian passport biographic page, and Nexus card.

Ms. [REDACTED] contests the surrender of her green card. She signed I-407 paperwork on [REDACTED], 2016 at the Pacific Highway Port of Entry, as the result of her misunderstanding of her rights as a lawful permanent resident and without the intent to formally abandon her status. She requests a hearing before an immigration judge in this matter.

I request that she be issued a Notice to Appear, along with a temporary green card to facilitate her entries into the U.S. while her hearing is pending.
